What to do?

2. Sign up for transportation, which may be done over the phone. We will need:
 - Your basic information,
 - Your appointment date,
 - Your appointment time,
 - Your appointment location, and
 - How long you expect to be there.

With this information, our staff will be able to determine the most appropriate transportation for your ride.
