Requires full compliance with the Head Start Performance Standards as well as State Child Care Licensing regulations.

Applicants must have a state issued Infant Toddler Credential, 1 or 2, or CDA, or CECA or Associate's Degree in Early Childhood Education preferred. Experience in a center or home-based setting specializing in infant and toddlers necessary. Must demonstrate strong interpersonal, and communication skills. Willing to work flexible hours to meet the needs of families.
