The Center Support Aide functions as a member of the Head Start center team. Responsible for providing support to teachers and kitchen staff as needed on a daily basis. Shares housekeeping tasks with team members to assure a clean, safe and inviting center. Contributes to ensuring the agency's full compliance with the Head Start Performance Standards.

The group leader or person having the primary responsibility for a group of children in a facility with thirteen (13) or more children shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age and meet one of the following:  
Credential. Child Development Associate (CDA) as awarded by the CDA National Credentialing Program. Experience. Six (6) months experience working in a Child Care Facility licensed for 13 or more children. College credits. One year (30 credit hours) of college work including a course in a child related subject.
