This person would be willing to be part of a team that creates a positive, welcoming, safe environment, where children and families can thrive.

The ideal candidate:

- Is someone who has a passion to make a difference and wants to have a positive impact on the lives of young children and families of York County.
- Is someone who is willing to make the commitment to receive formal training and education by completing a CDA.

Job Responsibilities:

- The Early Head Start Teacher is responsible for learning and assisting with planning, implementing, and documenting an effective, comprehensive child development program.
- Assumes responsibility of Primary Caregiving, assuring continuity of care.
- Supports family strengths and contributes to the development of family/child focused goals and timelines.
- Maintaining partnerships with families.
- Contributes to ensuring the agency's full compliance with the Head Start Performance Standards and Maine State Licensing Requirements.

Educational Requirements & Experience:

- Applicants must be willing to complete a CDA within one year of hire.
- Experience in a center or home-based setting specializing in infant and toddlers preferred.
- Must demonstrate strong interpersonal, and communication skills.
- The teacher must be an open, warm, caring and accepting person, and willing to work flexible hours to meet the needs of the families.
