Applicants must have a CDA; an Associate's Degree in Early Childhood preferred, or a related field with coursework equivalent to a major relating to Early Childhood Education. Must have experience in an early childhood setting. The teacher must be an open, warm, caring and accepting person, and willing to work flexible hours to meet the needs of the families.
