Contributes to ensuring the agency's full compliance with the Head Start Performance Standards and Maine State Licensing Requirements.

Applicants must have a high school diploma/ GED or HSE equivalent and have experience working with children ages 3-5. A CDA or CECA is preferred as well as experience with children with special needs. Children's Services will financially support applicant in obtaining CDA certification within one year of employment.
