- Is someone who enjoys meal prep/clean up and looks forward to working as part of a team providing nutritious meals for children and adults.

Job Responsibilities:

- Sanitation and preparation of the dining area.
- Transport breakfast, lunch and snack daily back and forth from the kitchen to the classroom.
- Work collaboratively with the Buxton Food Service Department to provide meals to the classroom.
- Provide classroom support to Teachers as needed.

Educational Requirements & Experience:

- Applicants must have a high school diploma, GED or HSE equivalent.
- ServSafe certification or must be willing to obtain after hire.
- Experience in the area of nutrition, special diets and sanitation preferred.
- Must be able to lift 40 pounds, reach to an area of two feet and bend to ground level.
- The Food Service Aide should be an open, warm, caring and accepting person and be able to demonstrate the ability to work cooperatively as a team member.
