#### **The ideal candidate:**

- Is someone who has a passion for the preparation of nutritious meals and wants to have a positive impact on the lives of young children of York County.

#### **Job Responsibilities:**

- For management and oversight of all kitchen duties.
- The Cook is responsible for guaranteeing children are served nutritious, tasteful, appealing meals and snacks according to approved menus that follow the CACFP guidelines.
- Prepare breakfast, lunch, and/or snack for enrolled children, staff, and visitors.
- Ensure daily function of all food service activities meets established expectations.
- Purchases all food and supplies necessary by placing order or weekly trips to the store and keeps records required by CACFP.
- The cook is responsible for proper food preparation, temperature control, sanitation, portion sizes and safe food storage.

#### **Educational Requirements & Experience:**

- Applicants must have a high school diploma or a GED.
- Must have ServSafe certification or willing to complete ServSafe certification asap after hire.
- Experience in the area of nutrition and food preparation is required, experience with infants, toddler's pre-school preferred.
- Must be able to lift 40 pounds, reach to an area of two feet and bend to ground level.
- The Cook must be able to perform repetitive work such as chopping, slicing, peeling, etc. for a minimum of two hours per day.
- The Cook should be an open, warm, caring and accepting person with leadership qualities, and demonstrate an ability to work cooperatively as a team member.
