VOLUNTEER DRIVER

Our Volunteer Driver Program provides transportation to York County residents who have no other means of transportation. Services include contracted transportation for children and families receiving case management from DHHS or Child Development Services, Cancer Care, rides for Veterans and other private contracts, as well as limited medical, non-emergency transportation for individuals who cannot be served on public transportation routes. Our dedicated Volunteers operate their own vehicles and are reimbursed for all mileage and tolls. The volunteer donates his/her own time, vehicle and driving skills. Before driving for YCCAC, all Volunteer Drivers will have their records screened by the Department of Health and Human Services, the Department of Motor Vehicles and the Maine State Police. They are also provided with on-going training and support.
