The Community Outreach Worker supports YCCAC's vision to address social service needs of patients in order to achieve improved overall health and well-being of patients. This position is crucial to move this vision forward and implement strategies to address the social determinants of health (SDOH). Specifically, the Community Outreach Worker works with clients referred by Nason providers to address SDOH diagnoses and other social needs. The Outreach Worker will work with clients to develop goals and an action plan, help clients access needed resources (internal and external), motivate patients to meet their goals, and support patients as they navigate various social service systems. The Community Outreach Worker will also provide appropriate documentation.

Educational Requirements & Experience:

- Bachelor's Degree in a medical, social services or human services field required with a LSW, LCSW, MHRT or other medical or clinical experience preferred.
- Has or is able to develop the complex care core competencies identified by the Campden Coalition of Healthcare Providers and the National Center for Complex Health & Social Needs in the domains of Human Complexity and Context; Personal and Professional Commitment to Ethics; Person-Centered, Relationship-Powered Care; Integrated Team Collaboration; Diverse Information Management; and Systems Complexity and Content.
- Must not have an active record on the System for Award Management (SAM) website.
