



If the federal shutdown has you worried about groceries, bills, or making ends meet, you're not alone—and help is here. Across York County and the state of Maine, local food pantries, emergency loan programs, and community services are ready to support you.

## **Immediate Relief**

- York County Community Action Corp (YCCAC): Offers a variety of services and programming for York County residents from all circumstances, particularly in times of transition and adversity.
  - Community Resources and Referrals Our Outreach Program serves as an entry point and place to learn about local supports and connect to resources near you. Direct line to Community Outreach Workers: (207) 459-2899.
  - Heating and Energy Assistance Apply for programs to help with your fuel and heating needs.

  - Children and Family Families with children may be eligible for free, high-quality early childhood education and childcare through our Early Head Start or Head Start programs. Contact the Head Start Program: (207) 459-2963.
    - Pregnant women, infants and children up to age 5 may qualify for food and formula supplements, nutrition and breastfeeding support through our WIC program. To contact WIC clinic locations in Biddeford and Buxton, call: (207) 283-2402, for Sanford, Limerick and Kittery, call (207) 459-2942.
  - Health Care Nasson Health Care provides primary medical, dental, and behavioral health care with a sliding fee scale available to residents of York County and neighboring communities. Health programs also include Maine Enrollment Assisters for the Marketplace and transportation to medical appointments and cancer care. Contact Nasson Health Care: (207) 490-6900.
  - Transportation Various options to provide you with reliable transportation and the ability to get you where you need to go work, shopping, school, medical appointments and other services.

## **Federal Employees Relief**

• Government Shutdown Loan Guarantee Program (LD 874): Up to three no-interest loans, each equal to monthly take-home pay (max \$6,000), for federal/state employees during shutdowns lasting 7+ days.

Federal and state employees should contact their financial institutions to see if they are participating in the loan program. Some financial institutions may have specific applications on their websites for interested lenders.

• FEEA (Federal Employee Education & Assistance Fund): \$150 micro-grants for essentials (groceries, gas, diapers). Eligible Federal employees are those who are furloughed or excepted, with salaries less than or equal to \$59,999 (or \$75,000 for NARFE members).
